This Pricing Supplement must be read in conjunction with such Offering Circular as so supplemented. Full information on the Issuer, the Guarantor and the offer of the Notes is only available on the basis of the combination of this Pricing Supplement and the Offering Circular.

### **Information Concerning Investment Risk**

Noteholders and prospective purchasers of Notes should ensure that they understand the nature of the Notes and the extent of their exposure to risk and that they consider the suitability of the Notes as an investment in the light of their own circumstances and financial condition. The amount payable on redemption of the Notes is linked to the performance of the Underlying (as defined herein). Given the highly specialised nature of these Notes, Morgan Stanley (the "Issuer") and Morgan Stanley & Co. International plc ("MSI plc") consider that they are only suitable for highly sophisticated investors who are able to determine for themselves the risk of an investment linked to the Underlying, are willing to take risks and can absorb the partial or complete loss of their initial investment. **Basket Components Risk:** The Notes will be redeemed at an amount determined by reference to the performance of the Basket Components and such performance will therefore affect the nature and value of the investment return on the Notes. **Exit Risk:** The secondary market price of the Notes will depend on many factors, including the value and volatility of the Underlying, interest rates, the dividend rate on the Underlying, time remaining to maturity and the creditworthiness of the Issuer. The secondary market price may be lower than the market value of the issued Notes as at the Issue Date to take into account amounts paid distributors and other intermediaries relating to the issue and sale of the Notes as well as amounts relating to the hedging of the Issuer's obligations. As a result of all of these factors, the holder may receive an amount in the secondary market which may be less than the then intrinsic market value of the Note and which may also be less than the amount the holder would have received had the holder held the Note through to maturity.

**Liquidity Risk:** Any secondary market in the Notes made by the Dealer will be made on a reasonable efforts basis only and subject to market conditions, law, regulation and internal policy. **No Shareholder Rights:** A holder of Notes will have no beneficial interest in the relevant Underlying nor any voting rights and will not have the right to receive dividends or other distributions with respect to the relevant Underlying.

**Potential Conflict of Interest:** The Determination Agent (MSI plc) is an affiliate of the Issuer and the economic interests of the Determination Agent may be adverse to the interests of holders of the Notes. Determinations made by the Determination Agent may affect the amount payable to holders pursuant to the terms of the Notes.

**Underlying Issuer Risk:** The issuer of the relevant Underlying is not an affiliate of the Issuer or its affiliates and is not involved with this offering in any way. Consequently, the Issuer and the Determination Agent have no ability to control the actions of the issuer of the relevant Underlying, including any rebalancing that could trigger an adjustment to the terms of the Notes by the Determination Agent.

**TAX CONSIDERATIONS FOR NON-U.S. HOLDERS:** A Non-U.S. holder will be subject to U.S. withholding tax unless the beneficial owner of the note (or a financial institution holding the note on behalf of the beneficial owner) furnishes a Form W-8BEN, on which the beneficial owner certifies under penalties of perjury that it is not a U.S. person. If withholding or deduction of taxes is required by law, payments on the notes will be made net of applicable withholding taxes, and we will not be required to pay any additional amounts to Non-U.S. holders with respect to any taxes withheld.

Under proposed U.S. Treasury Department regulations issued pursuant to Section 871(m) of the Code, if finalized in their current form, withholding at a rate of 30% (or lower treaty rate) would apply to certain “dividend equivalent” payments made or deemed made after December 31, 2015 to non-U.S. persons in respect of financial instruments that reference U.S. stocks. Under these rules, withholding may be required even in the absence of any actual dividend-linked payment made pursuant to the instrument. Because these rules apply only to instruments acquired after March 4, 2014, these rules should not apply to initial Non-U.S. Holders that acquire their securities in this offering. However, a purchaser of the securities after March 4, 2014 that is a non-U.S. person might be subject to withholding under these rules, depending on the facts as of the date of the acquisition. As a result, a Non-U.S. Holder’s ability to transfer the securities on a secondary market, if any, may be further limited because, depending on the facts on the date of transfer, a potential purchaser that is a non-U.S. person may be subject to withholding under these rules. Moreover, it is possible that a withholding agent may withhold on payments made to initial Non-U.S. Holders that purchase the securities in this offering if the withholding agent cannot determine the date on which the Non-U.S. Holder acquired the securities. Finally, in some cases even an initial Non-U.S. Holder that acquires the securities in this offering might cause the securities to be subject to withholding under these rules by acquiring additional financial instruments with respect to the underlying stock after March 4, 2014. If withholding applies, we will not be required to pay any additional amounts with respect to amounts withheld. These proposed regulations are extremely complex. Non-U.S. Holders should consult their tax advisers regarding the U.S. federal income tax consequences to them of these proposed regulations.

For the avoidance of doubt, this includes compliance with the selling restrictions mentioned herein;
- f) if you receive any fee, rebate or discount, you shall not be in breach of any Regulation or customer or contractual requirements or obligations and you shall, where required to do so (whether by any applicable Regulation, contract, fiduciary obligation or otherwise), disclose such fees, rebates and discounts to your investors. You acknowledge that where fees are payable, or rebates or discounts applied, the Issuer and Morgan Stanley are obliged to disclose the amounts and/or basis of such fees, rebates or discounts at the request of any of your investors or where required by any applicable Regulations.

- g) you will be committed to purchase at the issue price stated in the term sheet (or at the price otherwise agreed between us) instruments, when issued, in the agreed quantity and having terms, as provided in the definitive documentation, consistent with those in this term sheet (subject to any modifications agreed between us);
- h) we may enter into hedging or other arrangements in reliance upon your commitment, and, if you fail to comply with your commitment, your liability to us shall include liability for our costs and losses in unwinding such hedging or other arrangements;
- i) you agree and undertake to indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified and held harmless the Issuer, the Dealer and each of their respective affiliates and their respective directors, officers and controlling persons from and against any and all losses, actions, claims, damages and liabilities (including without limitation any fines or penalties and any legal or other expenses incurred in connection with defending or investigating any such action or claim) caused directly or indirectly by you or any of your affiliates or agents to comply with any of the provisions set out in (a) to (h) above, or acting otherwise than as required or contemplated herein.
- j) You are not purchasing the Notes as an extension of credit to Morgan Stanley pursuant to a loan agreement entered into in the ordinary course of your trade or business.
