EURONEXT DUBLIN 2ND DRESS REHEARSAL GUIDELINES AND DOCUMENTATION UPDATE

Executive Summary

Euronext has published guidelines for the Euronext Dublin dress rehearsal of 19 January 2019. The Euronext Dublin integration project migration guidelines and Off-Book On-Exchange market model have also been updated.

In addition, Euronext announces a Euronext Dublin trading membership freeze period for the two weeks prior to the Go-Live date.

Euronext informs customers that guidelines for the Euronext Dublin dress rehearsal on 19 January 2019 are now available online. The guidelines outline the expected tests to be run by clients in the Production environment during the **dress rehearsal** on Saturday 19 January 2019.

The Euronext Dublin **migration project guidelines** have been updated to integrate the list of detailed instruments available in the production environment.

Euronext Off-Book On-Exchange (OBOE) market model has updated trading deferral publication times.

TRADING MEMBERSHIP FREEZE PERIOD

Please note that Euronext cannot process membership extension requests or changes in clearing arrangements for the Euronext Dublin market between the 2nd dress rehearsal on 19 January 2019 and the Go-Live planned on **4 February 2019**, pending regulatory approval. Any requests received during this period will be processed after 4 February 2019.

Euronext invites clients to secure their membership to the Euronext Dublin market by contacting the Euronext Membership and Customer Connectivity team. Euronext also reminds clients that **OEG conformance, MDG and Saturn validation tests**, as well as **dress rehearsal** participation are **mandatory** prior to the planned migration date of **4 February 2019**, pending regulatory approval. Furthermore, clients are invited to participate in the end-to-end tests planned between 7 January and 18 January, as detailed in [EuroCCP's communication of 19 December 2018](#).

OPTIQ® ACCESS CONNECTIONS FOR THE DUBLIN OEG AND MDG CHANNELS

Clients are reminded that access to Order Entry Gateway (OEG) and Market Data Gateway (MDG) channels for the Euronext Dublin market must be requested directly from ICE Data Services. In preparation for the 19 January 2019 dress rehearsal in the production environment, Euronext Dublin reminds clients that:

- For clients hosted by an ISV/ASP, to liaise with their ISV or ASP to ensure their access to the Optiq® OEG and MDG channels have been set up;
- For clients connecting directly, to contact their sales representative at ICE Data Services, or send an email to icglobalnetwork-info@theice.com, to request access to the Euronext Dublin dedicated channels.

Euronext strongly recommends clients validate the order process by Wednesday 16 January in order to leave enough time for SFTI/ICE and Euronext to configure their accesses.
